EnvS 598 Internship Requirements

Basic Requirements. Intern must be a graduate student in Environmental Science. Please complete and submit the attached application form to the EnvS office before registering for an internship.

Registration. Intern must register for EnvS 598 for the semester in which the internship occurs. You may register for one, two or three credits depending upon the following criteria. One credit: observation and general work-related duties as assigned (minimum 40 hours effort); two credits: above plus demonstrated work product (minimum 80 hours effort); three credits: all of the previous plus demonstrated competence in the work environment (minimum 120 hours effort).

Evaluation Forms. Intern and internship supervisor (in the work place) should agree to an initial work plan. They must also agree to complete and return the attached mid-term and final evaluation forms to the Environmental Science Program. The supervisor is expected to discuss the evaluation with the intern before returning it to EnvS. **The return of the completed and signed evaluation forms and final report is your responsibility. No evaluations, no credits.**

Final Report. Students must submit a final written report the last week of the semester in which the internship is completed. The report must be typed and double-spaced, and should be no longer than three pages. It should address the following points:

A. The quality of the internship experience

- What did you learn and how does it apply to the field of environmental science?
- In which areas do you still need to improve or refine your knowledge and skills?
- If you could do it over, what would you do differently?

B. The organization and supervision

- Describe for whom you worked.
- How did your work contribute to the organization or workplace?
- Describe the feedback you received from your supervisor and fellow workers.
- If the organization offered you a job, would you take it? (Why or why not?)

C. Additional comments

- If you have additional comments not covered in the above A and B, please add them.
- Do you think your internship helped prepare you for work after college?

Final Grade. Internships are graded on a standard grading system of A/B/C/D/F/I. Failure to submit the completed mid-term and final evaluation forms and a final written report by the end of the term enrolled may result in a failing grade.
