a. Graduate Admissions: Transcripts requirement for the graduate application discussed.

To improve the application experience and allow students with multiple transfer credits to complete their application, we propose the following:

 Official transcripts of all college work will be required at the point of admission and must be sent directly to the Graduate Admissions Office.

Exceptions:

- Applicants who do not hold a post-bachelor's degree: transcripts from institutions where less than 9 semester hours have been earned and each course work and grades obtained appear on a different transcript as transfer credits will not be required. If a request to transfer credits into a graduate degree at the University of Idaho is requested, the official transcript will be required.
- Applicants who hold a post-bachelor's degree: transcripts from institutions where less than 18 semester
 hours have been earned and each course work and grades obtained appear on a different transcript as
 transfer credits will not be required. If a request to transfer credits into a graduate degree at the
 University of Idaho is requested, the official transcript will be required.
