Maximum/Minimum Weights

Market Animal Project members should be aware of the beginning and ending weight recommendations. This will still allow for the daily weight gain to be at a competitive level.

<u>Swine</u> should not weigh any more than <u>90 pounds at the initial weigh-in</u>. At the fair time weigh-in, it must be at <u>least</u> 225 pounds. Top weight for swine is 300 pounds.

The maximum weight for <u>sheep</u> at the <u>beginning weigh-in is 90 pounds</u> and <u>110 pounds</u> for a minimum at <u>fair time</u>. Top weight paid for sheep is 160 pounds.

The recommended beef will be no more than <u>850 pounds at start</u> and <u>1000 pounds</u> required at the fair.

The animals sold at the Market Animal Sale will only be paid for the maximum market desired weight, such as beef top weight will be paid up to 1400 pounds.
