GEM / BOISE COUNTY 4-H PROJECT MEDAL AWARD GUIDELINES

What is a county medal?

A county medal is a form of recognition awarded to a 4-H member for outstanding achievement and project work, above and beyond the project level at the fair. It takes into account goal setting, accomplishments, knowledge and skills gained, leadership and citizenship, communication and promotion.

- A separate recommendation must be filled out for each medal applied for. Applications must be completely filled out by the 4-H Leader or Extension Staff.
- All recommendations must be made on the official recommendation form.
- The portfolio will be used as part of the criteria for evaluation.
- All recommendations must be received by the Extension Office no later than the September Leaders' Meeting.
- Award selection will be made by the Gem/Boise 4-H Awards Selection Committee made up of qualified 4-H leaders. An Extension Staff member will act as advisor to this committee.
- Awards will be made only to deserving 4-H members.
- Submitting a recommendation does not mean a member will automatically receive the award.
- The decisions of the Awards Selection Committee are final.
